- * Manages a staff of 3 people: Parish coordinator, Director of Music, Organist

CHAPLAIN TO THE COMMUNITY

- * Provide pastoral care to all Mariner Sands residents throughout the year.
- * Conduct memorial and inurnment services for Mariner Sands residents and their families families as requested.
- * Conduct baptismal and wedding services for residents and non-residents as requested.
